RUGFEST 2010:

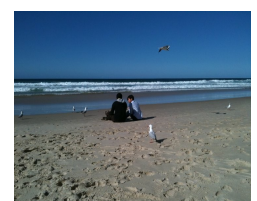
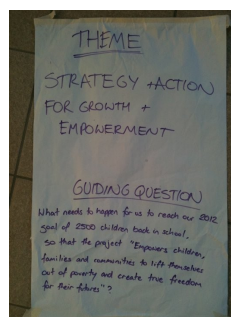
